COMMITMENT TO THE PROGRAM

The schedule at WBC Cross Current can be demanding. There are just so many opportunities to share your faith and grow in it — you're going to find yourself stretched! Is there anything that you feel will inhibit you from meeting this challenge? Such inhibitions will not disqualify you from joining the program, but you will need to display a willingness to grow in these areas.

Because our program is so demanding, we find it helpful to let students know ahead of time to not commit to outside opportunities during the week. While you will have most weekends and some week-day evenings free to serve at your church and help out at home, we cannot guarantee any night during the week as being regularly available. Your first commitment for the coming year needs to be to the growth in Christ that is waiting for you here.

ETHICS AND LIFESTYLE CODE

Winkler Bible Camp has adopted an *Ethics and Lifestyle Code*. It is as follows:

To conduct myself at all times during my stay at camp in accordance with my Christian conviction and standards as are set forth by Winkler Bible Camp.

- A. I will respect the authority of the organization's leadership staff, demonstrating a willingness to serve and be directed by others.
- B. I will always avoid situations with others which could, in any way, be misconstrued as inappropriate.
- C. I will refrain from sexual relations of any kind outside of the marriage relationship.
- D. I will honor the laws of this country, understanding that government is placed in authority over me by God, appreciating that breaking the law can jeopardize the safety of myself and others, and damage the reputation of this ministry in the community.
- E. I understand that total abstinence from alcohol while I am a student at Cross Current is required and realize that consuming alcohol (in public or private) and drunkenness constitutes grounds for dismissal.
- F. I will abstain from the use of tobacco products.
- G. I will abstain from the use of illegal, non-prescription drugs.

Abstinence, the conscious choice to avoid certain behaviors, is expected in regards to smoking, drinking alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, and other sinful behaviors specifically named in the Bible, so that we can encourage one another to live faithfully for Christ in our society.

WAIVERS AND CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT

1. The Camp Director and Cross Current Director reserve the right to dismiss a student who is in his/her opinion a hazard to the safety and the rights of others, or who appears to have rejected the reasonable guidelines set for student conduct (see Ethics and Lifestyle Code). In such event, the student is responsible for any travel expenses that may result from the dismissal. The student certifies that they are normal in condition and habits and are amenable to necessary discipline.
2. While every precaution is taken for the safety and good health of our students, Winkler Bible Camp, its directors, other staff members and other employees of facilities outside of the camp grounds are hereby released from any liability in the event of an illness, accident or misfortune that may occur to the applicant student. Each student must be insured by Provincial Health or equivalent medical insurance. Each student is responsible to have adequate travel insurance for the mission trips.
3. The signature of the applicant/parent/guardian on this application shall give the Camp Director or Cross Current Director the right to arrange for any special service or other requirements necessary for the best interests of the applicant and shall give the Camp Director or Cross Current Director the right to approve and obtain medical attention necessary for the applicants welfare and good health including injections, anesthesia or surgery. In such situations the camp will attempt to notify the emergency contact as soon as possible. The applicant/parent/guardian is responsible for any additional expenses that may result from such services.
4. The signature of the applicant/parent/guardian on this application shall authorize the appropriate police force to make any investigation of its records and enquiries of other police forces, which may be relevant to this applicant's involvement in camp functions.
5. The signature of the applicant/parent/guardian on this application shall give the camp permission to use pictures or video of the applicant for promotional purposes.

CROSS CURRENT FEE PAYMENT OPTIONS

Students are responsible for supplying their own financial support.

Scholarships are not available from Winkler Bible Camp Inc.

All fees must be paid in Canadian dollars.

Fees are not considered a charitable donation for Income Tax purposes.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

WBC Cross Current works hard to keep the costs of the program as affordable as possible — \$2500.00 per semester. Tuition is due on the first day of each semester and can be covered in one of two ways:

- 1. You can pay for the complete semester all at once. The office can accept payment through debit, credit cards, cash, or checks.**
- 2. You can set up a monthly payment plan using post-dated checks or automatic withdrawal. Forms for AW are available at the office.**

In addition to the tuition, there is a \$100 damage deposit that must also be paid on the first day of the semester. If, at the end of the first semester, there is a balance remaining in your damage deposit (there was no deductions for damage to your room), it will be applied to your second semester damage deposit.

Apart from personal spending money, you shouldn't need any other funds for your time here at the camp.

I understand that I am responsible for the financial obligations associated with being a student at WBC Cross Current and will make arrangements to have all payments made on time.
